

LEADING SPORT ORGANISATIONS TO HIGHER ENERGY EFFICIENCY



WHAT IS THE MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME?

To assist sport organisations in reducing their energy consumption by improving their overall energy performance through an increase in energy efficiency.

WHO CAN BENEFIT FROM THIS SCHEME?

Sport organisations duly registered with SportMalta who own their premises or are using Government property as their premises.

WHAT ARE ELIGIBLE INTERVENTIONS?



- Improvement in equipment efficiency.
- Energy related building envelope improvement.
- Reduction of energy consumption for heating and cooling systems.
- Improvement of lighting efficiency.
- Any other action not outlined above which is expected to result in energy savings of at least 20%.

WHAT ARE INELIGIBLE INTERVENTIONS?



- Improvement in equipment or systems which could have a direct impact on competition results/performance.
- Interventions addressing water systems which do not result in end use energy savings.
- Installation of photovoltaic panels.
- Consumables.
- Maintenance work.



GRANT DETAILS

The minimum eligible cost shall be **€250 excl. VAT** and the maximum eligible cost shall be capped at **€50,000 excl. VAT**.

The grant shall cover 100% of the eligible cost in the case of investments up to **€20,000 excl. VAT** and 90% of the eligible cost in the case of investments greater than **€20,000 excl. VAT** and up to **€50,000 excl. VAT**.



HOW DO I APPLY?

Applicants may apply for a grant under this scheme by means of the application form downloadable from SportMalta's website (www.sportmalta.org.mt)

Applications under this scheme may be validly received as from March 2019 till May 2019. The scheme may be modified or terminated before that date by means of a notice in the Government Gazette.
